 own sole use and benefit And I also give devise and bequeath unto my said
 Wife the sum of One hundred pounds which will be due upon my decease by
 virtue of an Indenture effected by me in the Royal Exchange Assurance Com-
 pany And as to the sum of five hundred pounds to which I am entitled by the
 Will of my Uncle Thomas Leobitter I give devise and bequeath the same by
 following that is to say as to the sum of One hundred pounds part thereof I give
 and bequeath the same to my said Wife for her sole use And as to the
 remaining four hundred pounds I give devise and bequeath the same unto my
 children male and female alike payable to them respectively upon their attaining
 their respective ages of twenty one years And whereas some of my said children have
 not attained their age of twenty one years I do hereby direct and the intent
 and meaning of this my Will is that the portions of some of my said children and
 have not attained their ages of twenty one years shall be placed out at Interest on
 Government or real Securities in the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named
 and the yearly produce thereof shall be paid to and allowed my said Wife during
 their respective Minorities for their board clothing and education of my said children or
 some other person as may be appointed in case of the death of my Wife before the
 youngest child shall have attained the age of Twenty one years And as to all other
 my personal estate and effects of what nature or kind soever I give devise and
 bequeath the same to my said Wife And I hereby appoint my said Wife
 and my brother Nathaniel Leobitter *Nathaniel* of this my Will In witness
 whereof I the said Testator have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my
 seal the seventh day of September One thousand eight hundred and thirty
 three *Leobitter* Signed sealed published and declared by the said Testator
 as and for his last Will and Testament the word "Twenty" being erased in the
 fifth line and the word "four" being also erased in the seventh line and eight
 substituted in lieu thereof in the presence of us who in this presence at his request
 and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names as witnesses
 as hereto *Willm Shurman James Stone*

 Doctor of Laws and Jurrogate by the Oaths of Mary Leobitter Widow the Relict
 and Nathaniel Leobitter the brother of the deceased the Executors to whom Adminis-
 tration was granted having been first sworn duly to Administer *W*

This is the last Will and Testament of me

 January in the year of our Lord
 One thousand eight hundred and thirty three as follows that is to say I give
 and bequeath to my two sisters in law Mary Huorles and Darnest Huorles of
 Suffolk aforesaid all my money securities for money plate linen wearing apparel
 goods chattels and property of any kind whatsoever of which I may be possessed
 at the time of my decease And I do hereby publish and declare this to be my last
 Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
