divided between them to have and enjoy for their own proper
use and behoof according to the true intent and meaning
hereof and I do also make and appoint my Son and Daughter
Henry and Penina Hayes above named to be my sole

and Joint Executor and Executrix of this my last Will
and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me
made for witness whereof have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this twenty second day of December in the third Year of
the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the
Third and in the Year of Our Lord God one thousand seven
hundred and Sixty two H. Henry Hayes Esq. signed sealed published
and declared as and for the last Will and Testament of Henry
Hayes the Testator in the presence of us who have hereunto
