Quirey William Dutton and Richard Dazard the sum of pounds betweene them for to buy each of them a ring and likewise the Doctor a ring this I make as my last will and testament utterly disallowing and annulling all former wills and legands and ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above written Thomas Charuotte his mark Signes sealed and delivered in the presence of Wm. Streett Esq. Wm. Norton Francis Bill.

 power and authority to receive the same wages debts and sums
 of money and to use all lawfull wayes and means for recovery
 thereof by suite arrest attachment distress imprisonment or other legall
 prosecution as the lawes will permitte and suffer and send attorney or
 more to substitute and the same at pleasure to receive and to compound
 fast order and agree and to doo all other things in the premises neede
 full as fully as I might or could doo if I were personally present ratifying
 and allowing the same by these presents and I the said John Clifford
 considering the uncertainty of this transitory life doo make and
 declare these presents to be my last will and testament that is
 to say all such wages summe and summes of money goods chattles &
 estate whatsoever wherewith at the time of my decease I shall be
 possessed or invested I doo give devise and bequeath unto my said
 friend John Adcroft and hereby nominate and appoint him my
 sole executor and hereby revoking all former wills legacies and
 bequests by me at any time heretofore made and giving or
 bequeathed my mind is that these presents shall stand remaine
 and abide as my onely true and last will and testament forever
 witness my hand and seal this fifth day of March in the yeare of
 our blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ 1692 and in the fourth
 yeare of their most gracious Majestyes William and Mary King
 and Queene of England Scotland France and Ireland defendours
 of the faith to whom God in his infinite mercy grant a long and
 a prosperous reign the mark of J. Clifford Signed Sealed
