Yeoman being at this present informed of body but of goods and perfect memory praised be Almighty God for the same. To make and ordaine this my last will and Testament in manner and forme following first and principally before all other things I do most humbly command my Soule into the hands of Almighty God my Creator confidently believing through the merits of his death and passion of his only sonne Christ Jesus my only Saviour and Redeemer to have the first and absolute remission of all my sinnes and offences. And as for my body my will is that the same bee buried in decent manner according to the direction of my Executor herein after named with the like hope trust and confident that it shall at the last day arise againe and bee reunited unto my Soule and from thenceforth remaine in all joy and blessednesse forevermore. And as for that which may befall of worldly estate wherewithal I have pleased Almighty God to bless me withall my will is as followeth. First I do give devise and bequeath unto my Sonne Edward Smith by best suite of wearing apparel Item I do give devise and bequeath unto my Sonne in law Cobert Kemp All other my weareing apparel whatsoever and also the summe of Twenty pounds to be paid unto him within six moneths next after my death Item I do hereby forgive and remitt unto my said sonne in law Cobert Kemp all such debts and summes of money as are now due and owing by him unto me either upon bond or otherwise provided that he do within thre moneths next after my death discharge my Executor hereafter named of and from all debts and bonds whatsoever wherupon I stand or am in regard to any person or persons whatsoever with and for him and his owne proper debt or debts Item I do give devise and bequeath unto my sonne John Smith (who hath bin sometime absent from me) the summe of

Twenty pounds of lawfull English money I haue, haue, and demand the same, personally
at the house where I now dwelle in Furpyn aforesaid within three years next after my
decease. Item I do give devise and bequeath unto my sonne named Smith (whothath
been also sometime absent from me) the like summe of Twenty pounds of lawfull
English money provided that he come and demand the same also personally
at the house where I now dwelle in Furpyn aforesaid within the term of
three years also next after my decease. All the rest and residue of my goods
and chattells whatsoever, real and personal, moveable and unmoveable
by me not herin formerly given willed or bequeathed (after my debts paid
my funeral expences discharged) And this my last Will so performed and
fullfilled I do give devise and bequeath unto my said sonne Edward Smith
whom I do make whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament
And I do hereby Revoke and Admisse and declare to be void all former Wills and
Testaments by me hitherto made. In witness whereof I the said Simon Smith
have to this my last Will and Testament sett my hand and sealed the day and
year first above written. Simon Smith his marke signed sealed and published
by Simon Smith the testator above named in the presence of John Stephenis John
Person Susanna Pearson her marke.

all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made. In witness whereof

Domini One thousand six hundred eighty and one, Thomas Smith his marke

publishing and declaring of the will above written.
